## Overview

Scavage is a game like no other that Lynbrook has seen. Make no mistake, Scavage is no less competitive than Spoons. You will be pitted against your peers and engage in a battle of wits. Only one can win.

#### **Prizes**

Players will be competing to win prizes:

- 1. The last player standing at the end of the game will win two Senior Prom Bids.
- 2. Members of the team with the most points at the end of the game will be entered into a raffle to win a Senior Prom Photo Package.
- 3. Senior picnic tickets will be raffled off. Raffle tickets will be hidden throughout the game so keep your eyes peeled!

## How to Play

Players will be assembled into random teams. The number of members and teams depend on the total number of players. Teams may be eliminated at the end of each week, but members may not be eliminated individually. Thus, if we were you, we would cooperate with the members in your team and love them unconditionally. Teams will be dissolved towards the end of the game, and players will compete as individuals.

We will be assigning teams. Teams are final. Or not.

Each week, we will be releasing a list of items we expect you to collect. If Items are located by Friday of the respective week and up to the Judge's standards, the highest number of points possible will be awarded for the Item. As far as point values go, points may be predetermined or assigned on the fly. The team with the highest amount of points at the end of each week will receive an exclusive sneak peek of the upcoming week's List 24 hours before the public Release.

Lists will be released weekly on Sundays at 4pm, no later and no sooner. We ask you to be patient because the Judges have lives (actually, maybe not).

Bottom 8 teams will be eliminated in Week 1. Numbers will adjust each week.

Decisions. All decisions are final. Period.

#### **Items**

Items are designed to be completed on your own time unless a judge needs to be physically present for your endeavors. Please be mindful of your own actions. Be aware that anything explicit or inappropriate will not garner you more points and you could be subject to disciplinary action. Points will be awarded on an all-or-nothing basis.

Items should be presented on Judgement Days which are Wednesdays and Fridays during Lunch. Items should be generally brought in and presented to judges physically. However, if explicitly stated, Judges may ask for additional proof via photo, film, or live demonstration such as strutting in the middle of the quad. Failure to comply may result in players' demise and immediate guilt.

For Items brought in, be punctual at the top of the quad. You must curtsy or bow before you present the items to the Ruler on the throne for the item to be judged. Video and photo proof should be emailed to <a href="mailto:2018scavage@gmail.com">2018scavage@gmail.com</a> before 11:55 PM Friday. Only one email per team may be sent per day. Replies containing new items are not accepted and Items in additional emails will not be accepted. So please try to fit as many items as you can in one email. It will be easier for us to track your Items, and you may also see more immediate feedback. However, you may send additional emails if Judges ask for a clarification or if a photo or video cannot be viewed or opened by the Judges.

If any Item has already been presented and was not accepted, no resubmissions are allowed. A team will be deducted one point every time there is a resubmission.

If you would like to dispute an item, you have until 2:00PM Saturday. If you are unsure whether an Item requires photo/video proof, we recommend you document it to be safe rather than sorry later.

Items should be self-explanatory. If we ask you for coffee, you must bring us coffee that is in liquid form, not text, a picture, video, or anything else. If you cannot figure out what we are asking for, creativity is encouraged so that you at least attempt to accomplish an Item. You may ask for clarifications by utilizing our ask.fm but we may not always grant answers.

If you believe we have unfairly awarded points, Item disputes may be filed <u>here</u>.

\*\*Due to the confusion around the usage of photoshop, all photo editing tools will be banned and cannot be used to assist you to complete items. Any form of manipulation to photos, digitally or by hand, will not be accepted.

## **Activities**

We want to make sure you have the physical, mental, and emotional strength necessary for survival before you leave high school. Activities will put these strengths to the test. They will usually occur during lunch on campus grounds. That being said, we do not provide lunch.

Read activity instructions carefully and send exactly the right number of people. If we ask for 2.5 persons, we expect to see 2 full persons and a pair of legs. Failure to comply with instructions will result in team elimination. Choose your tributes wisely. If your entire team is called upon, we expect to see all team members present. In the case that members cannot represent their team, please contact a Judge a full 12 hours prior to the event to make necessary arrangements. Contact made to excuse absences made within 12 hours of events will result in penalty of points against team.

Points will be awarded based on your team's completion or placement in the activity. First place will be awarded 20 points, second place 15 points, and third place 10 points. Anything past third place will not be awarded points. Beware, activities may also result in sudden eliminations.

You may spectate all activities and cheer on your teammates if you are not participating in the activity.

## Eliminations

At the end of each week, the team at the lowest standing will automatically be eliminated along with team(s) who do not meet the quota. We ask that you turn in your badges along with your honor and dignity. We appreciate your time and service. Please come again.

Keep your eyes peeled. If you are no longer playing, you may spectate or be a snake. We encourage continued participation for sustaining the level of hype.
