



Set, Slip, and Security (SSS) Crew

A group of approximately 10 parent volunteers (broken into smaller teams that rotate practice days) that helps the coaching staff with a variety of tasks. Those tasks include:

- arriving at the Mulderig Training Center 15 minutes prior to the start of practice to get daily instructions and help prep tools and equipment for the day.
- helping a designated coach with the set up and any re-sets of courses/activities during the training session.
- providing maintenance of training environments during training sessions (as needed/directed).
- helping to manage the flow of traffic and overall security of training environments (i.e. keep general public out of training areas, manage blind spots on hill, keep athletes moving but not "skiing up" on one another, etc.),
- helping with tear down/clean up.
- communicating via radio with coaching staff (as needed).

There is no background knowledge needed to join this group, but it does require a strong skier who can carry a loaded (heavy) gate bag. The coaching staff will teach all other skills you might need as we go.

Some days this crew/team may just be needed for 30-45 min at the start of practice. Other days, it may require that some or all of the crew remain on duty for the entire training session.

Members of the SSS Crew must register with USSS as a volunteer (if you don't already have another valid membership), and must complete the online training/background screening that USSS requires. The DCWST will reimburse your USSS membership registration costs at your request.
