Dear Incoming Grade 6 Students and Families,

The MPS PK-5 World Language Program has offered your child the opportunity to explore Spanish language and culture throughout elementary school. As your learner enters middle school, we are excited to provide the opportunity for continued language learning. With an emphasis on proficiency in the target language, Grade 6 World Language courses focus on application of reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills aligned with the [CT World Language Standards](#).

Our district's Grade 6th, 7th, and 8th grade World Language program includes full-year study of one language - Spanish, French, or American Sign Language. As your child prepares to enter Grade 6, they will have the opportunity to rank preferred languages for the 2026-2027 school year. PLEASE NOTE: While we will use student requests to guide language assignments, students will rank their preferences and course assignments will be made based on availability and scheduling needs.

Students and families will be able to discuss this important decision and rank their preferred languages via PowerSchool. **Please complete the course selection process by Thursday, April 2nd.** We have provided step-by-step directions for completing this process below.
