Do-While Loops

Save this project as 'QuitProgram'

Using a Do-while, write a program that continually asks the user if they want to quit the program, until they finally enter 'y' or 'Y'. At that point, the program should end.

Note: We use a Do-While loop in this program because no matter what, we want to ask the user if they want to quit the program at least once.

Example:

```
<terminated> QuitProgram [Java Application] C:\Program Files\Java\jre7\bin\javaw.exe (Nov 17, 2014, 9:20:42 AM)
This program does nothing. It will continue to do nothign until you tell it to stop.

Do you want to quit this program yet? [y/n]: n
Do you want to quit this program yet? [y/n]: n
Do you want to quit this program yet? [y/n]: n
Do you want to quit this program yet? [y/n]: y

Thank you, have a nice day!
```
