I. Purpose

The purpose of this bill is to support the Boise State University Recreation Center by allocating funding for the purchase and installation of essential equipment, such as the Freemotion Dual Cable Cross G624-IU and cable attachments.

II. Rationale

WHEREAS, this investment will expand strength-training accessibility through the addition of resources for various types of students;

WHEREAS, the additional equipment will help reduce wait times, hence improving the overall experience for students at the Recreation Center;

WHEREAS, modernizing the Recreation Center with state-of-the-art equipment reflects the high standards of Boise State University and its commitment to student excellence;

WHEREAS, when the experience at the Recreation Center is positive, it will lead to more usage and support from the student body;

WHEREAS, students will be on campus for a higher threshold of time, which will build more community;

WHEREAS, the demand for the Boise State University Student Recreation Center is consistently high, serving approximately 2,500 students daily,

WHEREAS, the Recreation Center recorded approximately 400,000 individual visits in 2025, tracked through door-entry scans. This figure reflects individual facility usage and does not include tours or organized group activities entering the center.

WHEREAS, the high traffic of the Recreation Center makes it the second most utilized resource on campus;

WHEREAS, represents one of the most high-impact areas for student investment;

WHEREAS, the Student Recreation Center has experienced continued growth in student usage, resulting in increased demand for cable-based strength training equipment;

WHEREAS, three cable rope attachments were removed from circulation last semester, and replacement attachments are necessary to maintain adequate equipment availability;

WHEREAS, expanding cable access through the addition of a dual cable cross machine and rotational attachment options will provide students with greater exercise versatility, improved training functionality, and alignment with current industry standards;

WHEREAS, these pieces of equipment are versatile and up to industry standard;

WHEREAS, physical health has been seen to directly affect mental health, academic performance, and functional movements;

WHEREAS, the support of the Recreation Center shows support for the holistic student as a person;

WHEREAS, this direct investment shows long-term support for the goals of Boise State University;

WHEREAS, the Student Recreation Center has expressed support for identifying, quoting, and installing the proposed equipment pending funding approval;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that ASBSU will allocate funding to reimburse the Boise State University Student Recreation Center for the purchase, freight, delivery, and installation of the Freemotion Dual Cable Cross G624-IU and associated cable attachments.

III. Account Drawn From

Funds will be withdrawn from the ASBSU General Fund.

IV. Provisions

An amount not to exceed \$8,404.91 shall be allocated from the ASBSU General Fund to reimburse the Boise State University Student Recreation Center through the established Inter-Departmental Charge (IDC) process for the purchase, freight, delivery, and installation of the following equipment:

1 Freemotion Dual Cable Cross G624-IU – \$8,999.00

2 Rogue Single Handle Cable Attachments 32 mm Aluminum Handle – \$58.00 each (\$116.00 total)

3 Umax 3D-Rotation Crossover Handles—\$69.00 each (\$138.00 total)

4 Umax 3D-Rotation Straight Bars – \$69.00 each (\$138.00 total)

5 Umax 3D-Rotation Low Row Handles—\$88.00 each (\$176.00 total)

The subtotal for equipment is \$9,567.00, with an applied discount of \$1,898.89, resulting in a discounted equipment total of \$7,668.11. Additional costs include \$537.80 for freight and \$199.00 for delivery, assembly, and installation, bringing the total cost to \$8,404.91.

The provisions of this bill shall go into effect immediately upon passage by the ASBSU Senate and Assembly and approval in accordance with ASBSU governing procedures.

V. Fiscal Impact

The total cost of this bill shall not exceed \$8,404.91, inclusive of equipment, applied discount, freight, delivery, and installation.
