Homework assignment.

Lesson: TECHNIQUES.

Pitch, Scales, tone tendencies, open and closed phrases, phrase starts and ends, rhythm. Explore ways of creating melodic movement. Melodic outline/melodic

contour.

Lesson: EXPLORING MELODIC STRUCTURE.

Deeper exploration of melodic structure: Overall Verse/Pre/Chorus,

Chorus/Bridge/Chorus, other structures

Lesson: EXPLORING MELODY GENERATING TECHNIQUES.

Explore ways to generate melodies: Lyrics, Title, Emotion, Chords, Riff, Bass Line,

Beat. Reading: The Artist's Way. <u>Composition homework assignment.</u>

"Lyric Writing"

Lesson: TECHNIQUES: Rhyme, lyric song structures.

Homework assignment and rhyme/structure composition assignment.

Extra credit: write a lyric without rhyme

Lesson: TECHNIQUES: Story, point of view, point of maximum dramatic tension (MDT), other common attributes in HIT SONG LYRICS.

MDT composition assignment

Lesson: Emotional Truth in lyric writing | The Lyric Holy Trinity: Writing lyrics that are UNIVERSAL, REAL and URGENT

Emotional Truth composition homework assignment.

Lesson: TECHNIQUES: poetic metaphor, visual pictures, plain spoken lyrics and when to employ each. *Visual picture and metaphor composition HW*

"DAW Track Writing/Arranging"

Lesson: EXPLORING TECHNOLOGY and how not to let technology distract you from writing a hit song. Definition and importance of TRACK hooks; explore hook examples. Explore which DAW works best for you, and why. <u>Homework assignment.</u>

Lesson: Explore TRACK ARRANGEMENTS, how to decide which section of the song goes where. How to build up the beat, tips for recording instrument and vocal guides. *Homework assignment and composition assignment*.

Lesson: Exploring 'FOUNDATION FIRST'--building the beat/bass line first, 'do's and 'dont's' for what order to add/replace guide instruments and vocals. *Homework* <u>assignment and composition assignment.</u>

Lesson: VOCAL PRODUCTION Explore the importance of giving the vocalist just enough to inspire them to cut an emotionally riveting vocal. Some vocalists need a full track, some vocalists need just one instrument and a click to sing to. Efficient recording with multiple playlists in Pro Tools.

"Intentional Songwriting"

Lesson: Explore how to CAPTURE and CRAFT melody, lyric and track ideas, and achieve CONSISTENT, INTENTIONAL, melody, lyric and track perspective when composing. *Homework assignment and composition assignment.*

Lesson: EXPLORE the use of your UNCONSCIOUS to allow for melodic, lyrical and track inspiration; the importance of generating 'OUT-OF-THE-BOX' lyrical ideas; the importance and how to use your CONSCIOUS mind to craft melodies, lyrics and tracks

Lesson: EXPLORE MELODIC/LYRICAL/SONG STRUCTURE.

Exploration of melodic structure, lyric structure, overall song structure. The importance of prosody to make a melody/lyric sing; the difference between poetry and hit song lyrics.
