1.	98) Boundary Waters Permanent Protection: Be it resolved that: The Minnesota DFL supports federal and state permanent, long-term legislative protections to permanently ban sulfide-ore copper mining in the Rainy River Watershed and the complete ban on mining in the Boundary Waters watershed. (Cry-W1 P1, GV-P2, GV-P7, R-W2 P1)	358
2.	7) Repeal Citizens United: Be it resolved that: The DFL supports laws or constitutional amendments, such as the "We The People" amendment, that repeals Citizens United and establishes that corporations are not "persons" with respect to campaign finance and election-related speech.(R-W2, R-W3)	349
3.	13) States: Illegal Sharing Voter Rolls: Be it resolved that: The MN DFL supports fighting federal pressure to share MN voter rolls and commits to ensuring MN voter confidentiality and fair election process. (GV-P8, Cry-W3 P1)	347
4.	5) Indigenous Treaty Rights: Be it resolved that: The DFL supports the state of Minnesota upholding all of our treaties with the Indigenous Minnesota tribes, including those involving <i>manoomin</i> (wild rice). (GV -P3)	344
5.	20) DFL Opposes Inhumane Immigration Enforcement: Be it resolved that: The following line be added to the DFL Platform: "We Oppose policies and procedures that lead to inhumane treatment of immigrants in our communities, and/or to their illegal deportation." 6.	23) Prosecute ICE Be it resolved that: The DFL supports prosecuting ICE agents and leadership that violated the law, and calls for full investigations that include local and state authorities, including the murders of Renee Good, Keith Porter Jr, and Alex Pretti, and Impeaching Kristi Noem (NH-P2, R-W2, PlyL-W3 P16, Cry-W4 P1, GV-P1. GV-P2)	343
7.	17) Right to Privacy. Be it resolved that: The Minnesota DFL supports the right to privacy in all areas of life, including but not limited to the personal healthcare decisions, digital communications and information, and freedom from unwarranted government surveillance. (R-W4, R-W2, NH-P1, NH-P2, Cry-W3 P1)	343
8.	1) Sustainable Agriculture: Be it resolved that: The DFL supports funding for research, technical, assistance, and education to rapidly implement regenerative farming, establish perennial crops, rotational	341

	grazing, cover crops, and no-till farming, to invest in rural communities and our food and farming system, conserve and build healthy soils, clean our water, sequester carbon and bolster farm income. (R-W2)	
9.	12) Elections Be it resolved that: Elections shall remain run by the States, not the Federal Government. (Cry-W3 P1)	340
10.	8) The Minnesota Equal Rights Amendment: Be it resolved that: The DFL Party make the Minnesota Equal Rights Amendment a top priority in 2026: ensuring that the rights of all Minnesotans are secured into our strongest legal document,; thus promoting a robust MN State ERA to ensure passage through the MN Legislature this session; leading the charge for a successful state ERA ballot initiative campaign. 11.	101) Stand Up for Minnesota's Water: Be it resolved that: The DFL Party supports clean water and supports a policy that would protect Minnesota's many waters from the dangers of copper-sulfide mining and protect Minnesota from the foreign mining companies seeking to exploit and profit from our resources. 12.	28) ICE Out of Minnesota Schools: Be it resolved that: The Minnesota DFL supports protections from immigration enforcement for students in Minnesota schools, using methods such as: 1) Ensuring students who miss school because of safety concerns around immigration enforcement are not penalized; 2) Supporting schools to have the flexibility for remote or virtual learning; 3) Supporting legislation that prevents immigration enforcement from operating within a radius of schools, campuses, and daycares (GV-6, GV-P5, NH-P8, GV-P1, NH-P7, R-W2, Cry-W3, R-W4)	334
13.	133) Tax the Rich: Be it Resolved that:The Minnesota DFL supports making Minnesota's tax system more progressive by (1) creating a fifth income tax tier for very high incomes; (2) closing tax loopholes and ensuring large profitable corporations and large nonprofit entities pay their fair share through appropriate taxes and fees; and (3) using the revenue to fund crucial public services and strengthen Minnesota's budget. 14.	102) Assault Weapons, High Capacity Magazine: Be it resolved that: The DFL party supports banning the sale, purchase, transfer, loan, transportation, distribution, importation, and manufacture of assault weapons and high capacity magazines. (NH-P7; GV-P2, GV-P6, Cry-W4 P1, R-W2)	331
15.	4) Medical Aid in Dying: Be it resolved that: The DFL support Medical Aid in Dying (MAID), allowing terminally ill, mentally capable adults to have access to end-of-life options to make decisions that are best for them and their families. 16.	29) School safety & Security Resolution: Be it resolved that: The Democratic Party support legislations prohibiting ICE and all other federal immigration enforcement officers from operating on or near daycares, schools, and college campuses without a judicial warrant or	326

17.	65) Protect Supports for Families: Be it resolved that: The DFL of Minnesota supports reversing the cuts to SNAP and health care and maintaining or increasing state and local supports for families to afford the basic necessities. (R-W2, Cry-W1 P1, NH-P4, P5, GVP-3)	325
18.	123) AI Deepfake Image Accountability: Be it resolved that: The Minnesota DFL supports legislation requiring platforms offering "nudity" or deepfake services to face significant financial penalties for each nonconsensual intimate image generated in Minnesota, and to update the definition of child sexual abuse material to include AI generated media. (Cry-W1 P1)	325
19.	14) No Changes in Minnesota Voter Identification: Be it resolved that: No changes in voter identification requirements will be made in Minnesota (Cry-W4 P1)	321
20.	43) Fully fund Childcare: Be it resolved that: Minnesota fully fund childcare so that the recommendations of the Great Start Task Force from February 2023 can be implemented on the timeline established by the MN Legislature so that no family pays more than 7% of their annual income for childcare and teachers are well-compensated for the work they do. (GV-8, Cry-W2 P1)	316
21.	10) Environmental Justice: Be it resolved that: The DFL supports reversing environmental impacts through funding to reduce pollutants in air and water and to increase soil's health and ability to uptake CO2. (GV-P3)	314
22.	100) Stop Trump's Attacks on Minnesota: Be it resolved that: The DFL Party supports clean water, the BWCA and will fight back against the Trump Administration's corrupt efforts to enrich foreign mining companies who want to exploit our public lands and clean water at the expense of our beloved Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. (GV-P4, Cry-W1 P1, NH-P2, NH-P7, R- W1 P-01, GV- P6, GV-P8, GV-P7, Crys-W4 P1, R-W3 P1, GV-P1)	311
23.	104) Limitations on Magazine Capacity: Be it resolved that: We, in the DFL Party, propose a ban on magazine capacity of greater than 20 bullets for rifles or handguns. This would involve a ban on new sales as well as a buyback program on previously-purchased magazines of higher capacity. (GV-P3, R-W2)	311
24.	95) Protect Groundwater Quality: Be it resolved that: The DFL supports policies that protect the health of all Minnesotans by ensuring access to clean, safe drinking water and providing free water testing, education, and remediation for private wells. (Cry-W1 P1)	311
25.	42) Fully Fund Public Education: Be it resolved that: Political leaders in Minnesota find the courage and the political will to raise taxes on the wealthiest 2 percent and largest corporations and fully fund Minnesota's public schools. (Cry-W2 P1, NH-P2)	310
26.	68) Universal, Single Payer Health Care: Be it resolved that: The DFL will commit significant resources to promote legislation that will create a health care system that puts patients over profits by enacting the Minnesota Health Plan at the state level and the Medicare for All Act (Jayapal/Sanders) at the national level. (Cry-W2 P1, NH-P3)	310

27.	93) Prevent Depletion of Groundwater: Be it resolved that: The DFL supports regional management of groundwater and requirements by large users to independently obtain withdrawal permits and conduct an Environmental Impact statement and aquifer pump test when usage exceeds 30 million gallons monthly or 40% municipal allocation, protection domestic use and aquifer sustainability. 28.	37) Improving Educator Pay: Be it resolved that: The state of Minnesota should make direct investments in the compensation of its educators including a starting wage of \$60,000 for teachers, a minimum wage for hourly workers of \$25 an hour and higher compensation for faculty in the state's colleges and universities including higher wages and dependent tuition waivers. (Cry-W2 P1)	309
29.	132) Fair Tax on Extreme Wealth: Be it Resolved that: The Minnesota DFL supports the enactment of a Fair Tax on Extreme Wealth that includes 1. A 2% "Billionaire Surtax" - net worth exceeding \$50 million. 2. Closing the Carried Interest and "Step-Up in Basis" Loopholes: Taxing investment income and inherited fortunes at the same rates as the wages of working people. 3. A "Democratic Reinvestment" Fund: Mandating that 132-revenue be dedicated to Universal Pre-K and Property Tax Relief, (R-W2 [2 resolutions])	309
30.	69) Establish MinnesotaCare for All: Be it resolved that: The Minnesota DFL supports the transition to MinnesotaCare for All, a universal, single-payer system that: Guarantees Coverage: Automatically covers every resident from birth through life; Eliminates Out-of-Pocket Barriers: Removes deductibles and co-pays so that care is based on medical need, not ability to pay; Comprehensive Benefits: Includes dental, vision, mental health, and long-term care as essential services; Cost Control: Uses statewide unified billing and price negotiations to drastically reduce the cost of care. (R-W3,[3 resolutions], NH-P3)	308
31.	58) Limit Corporate Money in Elections: Be it resolved that: The Democrat Farm Labor party supports Minnesota laws be amended such that they shall not be interpreted as granting corporations the power to expend anything of value, directly or indirectly, to influence elections, and be written such that corporations otherwise shall continue to have all powers necessary for business operations, charitable activity, advocacy, lobbying. 32.	39) Affordable Health Care for Educators: Be it resolved that: Minnesota must provide affordable, quality health insurance to educators by creating a statewide insurance plan for all school employees. (GV-P6, Cry-W2 P1)	305
33.	122) Defense of Transgender Rights: Be it resolved that: The DFL shall resolve to preserve and restore equal rights to those who identify as transgender or gender non-conforming. (Cry-W1 P1)	301
34.	64) Protect Our Trans Community: Be it resolved that: Gender Affirming Care is legitimate, life-saving medical care and that trans individuals should not be barred from seeking it. Medical services should also not be prevented from being provided to these individuals by Government interference driven by failure to recognize these individual's humanity and autonomy. Funding should not be withheld	300

	from hospitals and trans individuals should not be villainized for seeking care. (R-W3)	
35.	15) Condemning White Christian Nationalism: Be it resolved that: The DFL commits to condemning White Christian Nationalism in all forms and considers it a threat to democracy; Committing to educate voters and its own members about the rising threat of White Christian nationalism; and emphasizing the platform support for separation of church and state as enshrined in our constitution. (Cry-W3 P1)	298
36.	19) No ICE Quotas: Be it resolved that: Quotas of detentions or border arrests by I.C.E. are eliminated and ICE only detains individuals, who have been convicted of a crime, with a judicial warrant. (Cry -W4 P1)	297
37.	6) Dignity: Be it resolved that:The DFL Protect civil rights & free speech for every person in Minn. Independent Journalism. (NH-P8)	296
38.	59) Repeal the Big Beautiful Bill: Be it resolved that: The MN DFL Party direct Democratic legislators to vote to repeal the big beautiful bill passed in 2025 by Congress. (R-W2)	296
39.	9) Rights to Gender Affirming Care: Be it resolved that: The DFL supports Amending the section of Civil, Human, and Constitutional Rights to include the following language about gender affirming care: "the rights of trans, non-binary, and two-spirit individuals to access gender affirming care" (NH-P8, GV-P2, Cry-W3 P1)	295
40.	45) Protect Against Data Centers: Be it resolved that: We, in the DFL, support a strict statutory framework limiting permitting and construction of data centers to ensure that Minnesota's energy, water, finances, and resources are protected against all facilities that increase air and water pollution, energy infrastructure risks, and to ensure rate payer costs are protected. 41.	25) Civilian services Not Militarized Immigration: Be it resolved that: The Minnesota DFL supports federal legislation to restructure and replace ICE and CBP with a system centered on human rights and civilian administration, including: 1. A Civilian Immigration Services Agency: Focused on case management, legal assistance, and work authorization rather than armed enforcement. 2. Humanitarian Reception Centers: Replacing detection cells with social service facilities staffed by medical and health professionals. 3. Strict Limits on Detention: Ending for-profit detention and establishing enforceable rights that prioritize community-based compliance. 4. Independent Oversight: Creating a permanent, transparent civilian body with the authority to investigate and hold agents accountable for misconduct. (R-W2, Cry-W2 P1)	293
42.	82) Strong Unions: Be it resolved that: Minnesota unites in a belief that our state can remain a place where everyone is able to live a secure, healthy and happy life; where all workers have the freedom to join together in strong unions to build a brighter future for our families and our communities. (Ply-W3 P16)	293
43.	31) Ensure Affordable Housing: Be it resolved that: The DFL party of Minnesota supports building more affordable housing across Minnesota, capping lot rent increases for quality manufactured home	291

	residents, helping families buy homes, and taking steps to lower energy and insurance costs so that Minnesota families can heat, cool, and repair their homes. (Cry-W1 P1, R-W2, NH-5, NH-4)	
44.	103) Secure Storage of Firearms: Be it resolved that: The DFL Party supports all gun owners be required to store their firearms locked and separate from ammunition. (NH-P7, GV-P3, GV-P6, R-W2)	291
