Visual Text Analysis Worksheet:

OBSERVE:

Step 1: Study the image as a whole for 2 minutes. Write down your initial impressions and reactions.

- People living in bad conditions/very poor
- Woman in front is kneeling to kiss her baby
- Everyone looks very happy for not having much
- Bright colors match the mood of the photo
- Focus is on the woman and her child everything in back is blurry and doesn't matter

Step 2: Divide the image into quadrants. Study each quadrant for 1 minute. What new details become visible? **Quadrant 1:**

- Busy men in back working on something
- Everyone is working with what they have and trying to get the best for themselves and their families
- Everyone looks fairly relaxed

Quadrant 2:

- Similar to first quadrant
- There is another mother and it looks like she is sorting some sort of food/grass item

Quadrant 3:

- The woman has brightly colored, very beautiful pants
- Can't quite tell but looks like it's the same material as the baby's bed
- She probably made her own pants

Quadrant 4:

- The mother and her baby mother obviously loves baby a lot
- Looking closely it appears that the mother isn't smiling
 - Shows that although the love is real, she feels that it is draining herself to put so much love into something and she is exhausted
