TEACHER WORKDAY: There isn't a big list of TO DO's, but there are some VERY important tasks to complete to ensure you meet the end of year professional and instructional goals!! Here are some ways you should spend your time Monday:

- Classroom environment Study change over from Insects to Reduce, Reuse, Recycle (Remember it's OK to keep some evidence of the Insect study in your room, especially since we are still observing the butterfly metamorphosis process and students are still very interested in this topic.)
- Data Driven Instruction (DDI) Dive into the data and create a long-range small group instructional plan *Brigance* & *PA data*
- Lesson planning:
 - Continue to include gross and fine motor learning targets in your weekly lesson plans (identify students who need specific skills practice Brigance data)
 - Include instructional transitions that meet learning targets (identify students who need specific skills practice -Brigance & PA data)
 - Include individual plans for students who need intensive instruction (2-3 days a week during Choice Time) and supplemental instruction (1-2 days a week during Choice Time) Brigance & PA data
- Certified teachers update your Evaluation portfolio in preparation for your final visits
- Update Marco Polo playlist
- Update Ready Rosie playlist
- Locate the RRR Guided Edition (It is a photocopy book and not the one that came with the Creative Curriculum kit.)
- Locate <u>The Four Money Bears</u> book. If you can't find it, you need to ask your Site Director to order you another copy.
- Review the fidelity checklist and prepare your questions for our PLC fidelity discussion on April 1
- Create instructional resources to use for whole group, small group, and/or for individualized instruction that support your students' learning targets.
