

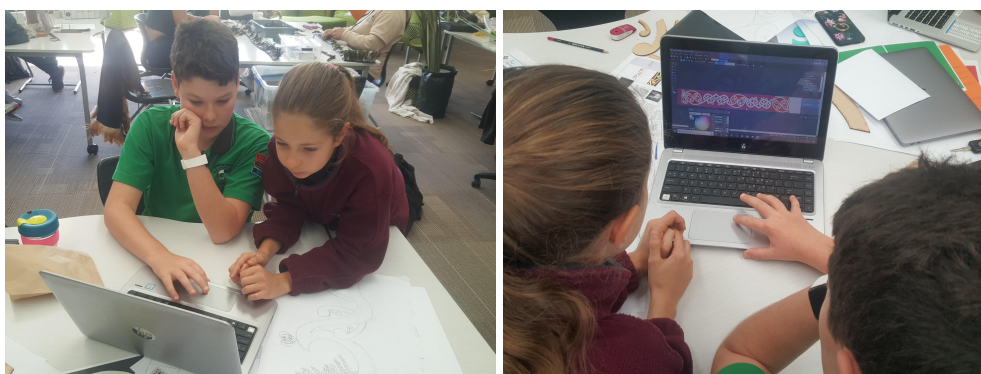
On the Horizon:

- **Whiria te Tangata Logo competition:** To end last year and begin this year, we ran a competition within schools. Alina Filip (Year 6) from Marina View School and Rory Neill (Year 8) from Riverhead won overall. Elements from their logo designs will be used in our final logo, and in the development of a kowhaiwhai pattern for the Kāhui Ako.

Robin spoke about the iwi, and shared some stories of her ancestors and our local area. The students then used this information, with some help from senior students and Whaea Leoni, to help design a kowhaiwhai pattern that will be shared and used within our Kāhui Ako.
