I. Getting Started
Launch PlayPosit from Canvas (<u>Tutorial</u>)
Quickstart steps: 1. Head to a course once logged into Canvas 2. Select Assignments 3. Click Add Assignment 4. After setting up assignment, scroll down to Submission Type 5. OPTIONAL: If you would like to set up a non-graded assignment follow these instructions 6. Choose External Tool from the dropdown and find PlayPosit from popup menu 7. Click Set Bulb Link to access your account
II. Add Video Content to PlayPosit (<u>Knowledgebase Article: Building a Bulb</u>)
Select Add New bulb
Add a video from Kaltura, YouTube, or Vimeo Kaltura dual stream support is available - for info, <u>click here</u>
Once the video has been added: → Captions attached to the video will be pulled in automatically → Light trimming and cropping of the video can be done → Additional information on captions found here
Repeat the process to add multiple videos to a single bulb
II. Add Interactions (<u>Knowledgebase Article: Building a Bulb</u>)
Choose a template from the template gallery Add easy, effective engagement in one click → Add multiple templates to a single bulb → Templates get placed at designated points in the bulb → Content neutral questions are applicable to any lesson → Customization of wording, timing, placement is always an option
Adding a Manual Interaction → Press "Play" or drag to the point in the video you would like to add your interaction → Click "Add an Interaction" → Select the interaction type you would like to use

	→ Begin entering the question and responses of the interaction
	→ Use our rich text editor to enhance interaction with audio, images, equations,
	formatting, links, and more.
	→ Add feedback to provide additional support for learners
	Interaction Customization
	Determine if you would like to apply advanced interaction settings
	→ Choose where you would like the interaction to be placed
	→ Adjust timing or create a durational interaction (if needed)
	III. Adjust Playback Settings and Review (<u>Knowledgebase Article: Bulb Settings</u>)
	OPTIONAL: Add tags to organize your content
	Adjust Learning Experience
	→ Allow learners to rewind upon reaching interactions
	→ Allow learners to skip interactions
	→ Allow fast-forwarding
	→ Allow learners to retake
	Please note - learners' most recent attempt will be pushed to the gradebook
	→ Allow learners to export a worksheet of a bulb
	→ Allow learners to increase playback speed

	IV. Finish Linking Bulb (<u>Knowledgebase Article: Canvas</u>)
	Click on Canvas Icon next to bulb thumbnail
	Choose the learner experience - self-paced, broadcast, learner made bulb**
	Newly linked bulb will display as a gray screen - NOTE: only the bulb is visible to learners
	Click on options to:
	→ Export a CSV file of analytics collected on bulb
	→ Preview - allows you to view discussion forum or notes
	→ Monitor bulb - sync any grades that you may adjust (free response/discussion)
	Share Student Experience article with learners
ГП	→ Provides an understanding of PlayPosit experience

FAQ

How do captions work with PlayPosit?

 PlayPosit will pull in any captions that are already attached to the video (with the exception of auto-generated YouTube captions). If you have caption files to upload separately, you can upload your own .srt or .vtt files. More information on captioning found here.

• I want my learners to retake a bulb, what are my options?

- You have two different options as far as bulb or interaction retakes go
 - i. Allow Retries on Interactions: Use PlayPosit's <u>advanced settings</u> to alow multiple attempts on individual interactions.
 - ii. Allow Retries on the Bulb: If you would like to allow learners to retake a bulb entirely, you can select that option on the bulb playback options. Please be aware, PlayPosit will push the most recent attempt to the gradebook, not necessarily, their best attempt. As soon as a learner selects "retry bulb" it will reset and archive their previous attempt, which can be viewed in the data export.
- Please note: Even if you do **not** allow retries on a bulb, as long as the Canvas assignment is **open**, learners will be able to rewatch the bulb and review their previous responses.

• How does grading work between PlayPosit and Canvas?

 PlayPosit will send bulb grades as a percentage to equal the score of the Canvas assignment. Because of this, there is no need to make sure that the bulb's value is equal to the Canvas assignment's grade.

• Are the grades on my bulbs going to sync to Canvas?

- If you link your bulb as an assignment through the external tool following these instructions, then the grades collected on your bulb will automatically sync to the Canvas gradebook. If you link through the Rich Text Editor following these instructions, your grades will not sync.
 - i. Please note if you include free response interactions that are work 1 or more points OR manually graded discussion forums, you will need to go into the <u>monitor screen</u> to manually assess scores using our <u>grade all</u> <u>mode</u> before selecting "sync grades".

• If a learner is not able to finish a bulb in one sitting, can they resume where they left off?

 When you have your bulbs linked in Canvas, it will allow learners to leave and resume from where they left off when they return. Please note: Learners may have to fast forward to the point in the video that they left off at.

• Why are my learners being marked as "in progress?"

- Learners are marked as complete in the gradebook and their scores are synced only when they reach the very end of the bulb. Learners will need to see a "complete" screen, indicating that they are finished with the bulb and allowing their scores to sync. Please share this learner experience article with your learners to ensure that they are aware of this procedure.
- IF there are many learners who completed all of the interactions, but they did not reach the complete screen, feel free to head to the <u>monitor screen</u> and select "sync grades" to push their current score to the Canvas gradebook.

• Can I use my bulbs each semester?


 You can! PlayPosit supports Canvas course copy, so feel free to reuse your bulbs each semester. More information found <u>here</u>.
