Parker PTO Dues

- Still getting dues
- Currently at \$12,388

Enrichment

- Currently no enrichment for 6th grade planned
- Dr. Story will check with team leaders and then Dr. Story and Jen H. will connect

Restaurant Nights

- Harrows gift card fundraiser will be open for the month of February

- On track to Harrows is last one that we had budgeted for, in line to raise more than budgeted

Playing for Parker

Principal Review: Dr. Story

- The second semester has started
- Dr. Story discussed efforts school is using to help narrow skills gaps, including: Using project blocks time, recently hired Title 1 Math Tutor, started 12-week program of before school learning with Title 1 funding
- School is helping 8th graders with transition to High School and on 5th grade transition to Parker
- March 20th is decided as the date for the school dance

- Dr. Story meeting with 8th grade team leaders to finalize 8th grade celebrations. This includes Odyssey lunch cruise on June 10th with the 8th grade Coolidge students
- With the help of the PTO, the cost is down to \$95
- Snow days have pushed back calendar, so graduation ceremony will be the evening of the 16th
- There will not be a promotion dance after the ceremony, but developing plans to do something during school like party or festival
- Parents inquired about school's ability to hold graduation outside
- Dr, Story relayed that outside set-up is beyond the scope of what facilities team does and vendor quotes are too high
- Auditorium seating can be a challenge, so communication this year will relay that ceremony is for immediate family only
