1. Academic

AL Vandertie Scholarship Senior boys basketball players who graduate on time, are attending college, and have not been suspended for an athletic code violation will receive a \$1000 scholarship. In 2025 we gave 3 senior members of the varsity boys' basketball program \$1000 each to further their education. We have given over **\$100,000** in scholarships since 2006. There is no other program at Arrowhead that has given so much to so many in their program. 8. Schedules

9. Dress / Attire

PRACTICE DRESS

All Arrowhead basketball players must wear practice uniforms to every practice.

Varsity: red and white and red and light blue practice uniforms, jerseys and shorts to be worn at all practices.

JV: to wear red and white practice jerseys from last year or purchase a new one this year.

JV2: to wear red and light blue practice jerseys

10. GAME DAY DRESS:

Varsity: will wear one of three options.

1. Arrowhead Basketball Gear i.e. “jump suits” or Other team apparel, “shooting shirts” etc..

2. A collared shirt, with a tie or sweater, dress pants (no jeans or sweats), dress socks, and dress shoes (no tennis shoes or sandals).

3. A tie, dress shirt, dress pants, dress shoes, and dress socks.

GAME TIME DRESS:

All Arrowhead players will wear game uniforms distributed by coach. No headbands, sweatbands, or jewelry will be worn during a game or practice.

Note: all coaching gear is purchased by Coach Haase no fundraising money is used to get coaching gear.

11. **Awards Policy**

Varsity Letter: any player who appears in 20 halves or more of Varsity competition and successfully finishes the season in good academic standing will receive a varsity letter. Any senior who has made a positive contribution to the Basketball Program despite the fact that he may not have played 20 half's will receive a Varsity letter. *NOTE: In order to receive any award all players and managers must attend the end of the season meeting and return all equipment.*

12. **Injuries** = Please communicate with the coaches if you know your son has an injury. It is critical that everyone understands that Basketball is a contact sport and therefore serious injury can happen. Players need to see the trainer if they are hurt. When a doctor or trainer informs me a player can NOT participate, the player will not be allowed to play unless cleared by that doctor or trainer.
