Need to know what we mean by organized by or compliant with APG

Need two methods:

- 1. one for those who have no taxon table and no records entered, to be accomplished via MySQL command upload
- 2. one for those who have an existing taxon table and collection object records

Need source for non-angiosperms

- 1. Monilophytes (Pteridophytes)
- 2. Bryophytes
- 3. Lichens
- 4. Fungi
- 5. Algae

Things to note:

- --not every taxon in APG is classified into a higher level, nor is every taxon in some of the other groups
- --The Specify tree goes all the way up to "Life"; how far up the taxonomic hierarchy is it necessary to go for our needs? APG only goes so far.
