Need to know what we mean by organized by or compliant with APG

Need two methods:

1. one for those who have no taxon table and no records entered, to be accomplished via MySQL command upload
2. one for those who have an existing taxon table and collection object records

Need source for non-angiosperms

1. Monilophytes (Pteridophytes)
2. Bryophytes
3. Lichens
4. Fungi
5. Algae

Things to note:

--not every taxon in APG is classified into a higher level, nor is every taxon in some of the other groups

--The Specify tree goes all the way up to "Life"; how far up the taxonomic hierarchy is it necessary to go for our needs? APG only goes so far.

Explore ITIS as a possible source

Explore taxonomic references/sources for all groups above

Explore possibility of Specify involvement in our working group to solve this problem
