About the Lloyd and Bette Drossart Scholarship

Lloyd and Bette Drossart lived in the Casco area all of their lives. Both graduated from Casco High School and always supported higher education for their children and others. Lloyd was employed by Wisconsin Public Service for over 30 years and was very involved in an abundance of community service and volunteer activities. Bette was a customer relations representative in a local bank for over 40 years. Together Lloyd and Bette owned an apple and cherry orchard. Both Lloyd and Bette were involved in their church and together value integrity, honesty, and hard work.

TERMS OF THE AWARD

This scholarship will be given to graduating seniors intending on furthering his/her education at a two or four year college or university. \$1,000 will be made to a deserving applicant for the first year and \$1,000 for the second year of schooling if a 3.0 GPA or above is maintained. The applicant must be accepted or enrolled in a continuing education program.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based primarily on merit but also financial need. Preference will be given to those whose meet the following criteria:

- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Have a record of demonstrated leadership and participation in extracurricular activities
- Have a record of community service
- Demonstrate a financial need

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection committee will review all complete applications based on the above criteria. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The scholarship will be awarded to only those deserving as determined by the selection committee. Therefore, the selection committee reserves the right to not award a scholarship in a given year.

PAYMENT OF AWARD

The award will be forwarded in the form of a check made payable to the student to during the second semester of their freshman year, after the transcript and receipt of tuition from first semester is received. The award will not be made without verification of actual enrollment and a 3.0 or better GPA. Please make sure appropriate contact information is provided.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Students must complete this application and a typewritten essay.

Your essay should be no more than 750 words. It should address:

- What are your career and educational goals?
- Why are you interested in this profession and why do you think you will be successful?
- How will this scholarship help you serve others in the future?
- Describe your financial need. How do you plan to pay for your college education?

Submit the completed application, with the essay attached, to your school counselor. The application maybe filled out in ink. The essay portion **MUST** be typed.
