## Update In-Person Learners: October 25, 2020

Greetings-

As a school, we continue to do an excellent job of staying safe to stay open. We have reset our classroom and lunch spaces to ensure that students and staff are physically distanced 6 feet away (no close contacts) from each other, masks are being properly worn, our furniture is frequently sanitized and we have plenty of hand sanitizer. I am very proud of how everyone is doing their part. Our safety protocols will continue to be our highest priority.

As part of our reopening plan, we are creating a mask break schedule. Mask breaks are an opportunity for staff and students to get outside during 2nd and 4th block to take a break from wearing a mask. From the time that the students leave their class and return to their class is 10 minutes. The breaks are mandatory for all students and we will continue to take them during every 2nd and 4th block, unless it is raining or ridiculously cold (actual temp or wind chill is 10 degrees or lower). Students should wear a coat to school.

Before we can set our 2nd Term individual class room assignments, we need students to consider the following:

### **ACTIVITY BANNER COMPETITION:**

Each club/activity has the opportunity to compete in a **Homecoming Banner Competition**. The winning club will receive a \$100 cash prize for their club. Banners may not be more than 5' x 8' and must include the Homecoming theme and the name of your organization.
