What's Jaap, y'all? Don your dance shoes for this set of Bulgarian dances learned from teacher and choreographer Jaap Leegwater.

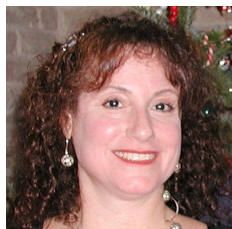

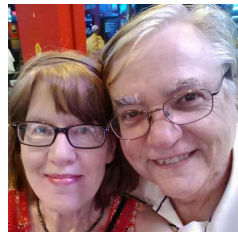

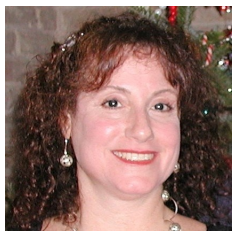
