- -Look closely at title
- -Try to make connections with title

<u>Summarize</u>- When you summarize, you are putting what you have read into a shortened, more concise form. You are basically "summing" it up. Make sure to always use your own words!

Question.-When reading, it is perfectly normal to have questions. Write these questions to the side of your passage. There is a very good chance that when you are finished reading most of these questions will have been answered.

<u>Underline-As</u> you are reading, it is extremely important to underline words and information that you think is important to understanding the passage. This should include dates, facts, nouns, and anything else which seems vital.

Answer- Make sure you know exactly what each question in asking. Mark key words such as *most, best, not etc.*

<u>S</u>can-Look carefully over your work. Did you answer every question? Are you satisfied with your work?
