Course Description:

This course is designed for the student who either desires a more thorough understanding of America's historical background, or is interested in an in-depth study of U.S. history as preparation for college. The course begins with the Constitutional foundations of this country, and then moves to an in-depth study of United States history in the 20th Century. The primary emphasis in this course is on historical analysis and perspective. College level reading, independent research, and writing skills are necessary in this course. Students should plan on 1 hour of homework per night.

In order to receive the Honors distinction, the student must receive a passing grade on the District's Honors US History exam in June.

Students must read at or above grade level. Students must have experience writing essays.
