Gilbert W. Bauernfeind, 43, of South Packard Street, Cudahy, died late Friday afternoon in Milwaukee.

He was born in Berlin on Aug. 3, 1919, and was married in Oshkosh to Irene Hansan on May 9, 1942.

Employed as a bookkeeper, Mr. Bauernfeind served in World War II overseas for 22 months.

Surviving are his wife, Irene; two sons, William and James, and five daughters, Paula, Barbara, Mary Ellen, Margery and Elizabeth, all at home; his father, Adolph Bauernfeind, Oshkosh; four brothers, Louis Bauernfeind, Foxboro, Wis., Lawrence Bauernfeind, Portland, Me., Robert Bauernfeind, Oshkosh, and Orin Bauernfeind, Fond du Lac; one sister, Mrs. Howard Eaton, Oshkosh. His mother, Ida Bauernfeind, preceded him in death in August, 1962.

T/Sgt. Gilbert W. Bauernfeind, 99 Central avenue, having entered service April 30, 1942, served with the infantry, and won the Philippine liberation ribbon with one battle star, Asiatic-Pacific theater service ribbon, good conduct medal, and three overseas stripes.

T/5 Gilbert W. Bauernfeind is now stationed at Fort Meade, Md. Sergeant Bauernfeind served 22 months as a personnel sergeant in the southwest Pacific and was awarded the theater ribbon with two battle stars and the Philippine liberation ribbon with one battle star. He recently spent a furlough here visiting his wife, Mrs. Irene Bauernfeind, 99 Central avenue, and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. A. L. Bauernfeind, 940 Ninth street.
