To post your bulletin, click the plus symbol and type your thoughts. Include a title and your message.

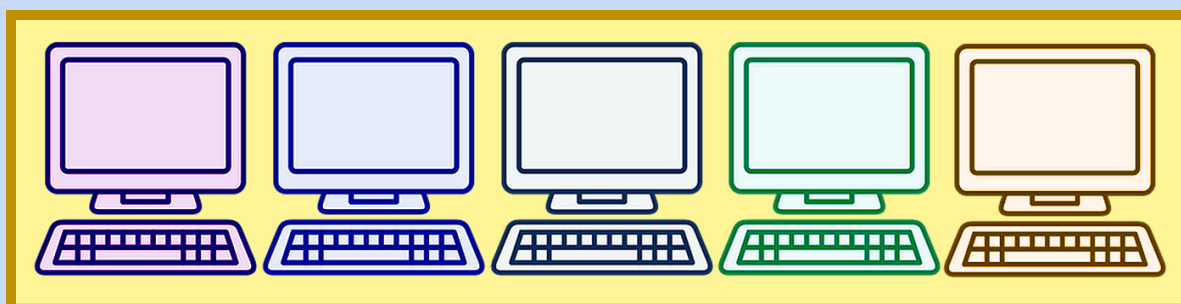
