The committee discussed the district, statewide, and state staff shortages. The section 4 & 5 staffing change request was approved by consensus.
Needs Assessment for 2022-23 school year	Committee Members	5:00-5:20	The committee reviewed the Needs Assessment Results, and discussed the good response rate of 27 staff members who had completed the survey. We observed that we had varying grade levels. Shawna mentioned that while the staff scored racial equity as the number one school-wide goal, the teachers did not mention it in their classroom needs. She also believes that the eye washing station the science teacher has requested should be addressed as soon as possible because she believes it is a safety issue. Amy will speak to Angela about this. Is it included in the renovation? Elizabeth wanted to know if we could address the teacher that needed the new laptop. Amy explained that this device issue was resolved. The staff member from the survey was the K-5 school counselor. The committee discussed that because the district only buys devices for teachers the school was responsible for the leadership teams devices. The state is now asking for a rationale for the make/model of devices purchased, and it was recently approved. Michaela Johnson asked if racial equity was considered when looking for the middle school math teacher position. Torri shared that the staff since summer of 2021 has written interview questions with racial equity lens. Amy shared that the hiring committee also completed training concerning equity. Elizabeth asked Amy shared that we are waiting on our budgetary allocation to move forward.
