

## DAYSTAR LIFE EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

As you prepare to participate in the Emergency rental assistance program, it is required that you are currently experiencing an “Emergency”. An Emergency is defined as an unexpected and significant expense or loss of income within the last 90 days that has severely impacted your budget if not immediately addressed. This means that under a non-emergency situation, your budget income is equal to or greater than your budget expenses. Examples of an Emergency could include:

- Loss of income (within the last 3-6 months) (proof of application to unemployment compensation)
- Loss of transportation or significant auto repair (proof of payment is required)
- Unanticipated health emergency (proof of medical bill payment is required)
- Natural disaster related damages (not covered by FEMA nor insurance)
- Personal tragedy

Essentially, an Emergency must have been “unforeseen” (an event that you could not plan or anticipate); poses an “immediate need” (requires prompt action); causes a “significant impact” (will affect your ability to meet essential living expenses). **Daystar is not able to help with Section 8 housing, income-based housing or deposit assistance requests at this time.**

If you choose to continue on in the application process, please review the required information/documentation listed below. Failure to provide any information will result in your application being denied. Application does not constitute neither approval nor denial. You can only apply for assistance for the current month, and the application will be open between the 5th and 15th of each month. Please note: Once you start the application, you cannot save your progress. If you exit, all entered information will be lost.

Required information/documentation:

- Paystubs or proof of income for one month for all Household members
- ID (Driver’s License, state ID card)
- Late notice received from landlord
- You will be required to enter any relevant Income information supported by documentation. This can include Net pay stub income, Food Stamps, Child Support, SSI/SSD income.
- You will be required to enter all relevant essential living expenses associated with Housing (rent, utilities, phone, internet/cable, etc.), Transportation (car loan payments, car insurance, monthly fuel expenses and car repair costs/maintenance, rideshare/Uber/Lyft expenses, etc.), Food/Groceries and any relevant Healthcare costs.
- You should also provide any other relevant monthly expense items not addressed above.
- Provide your Base Rent amount? (do not include appliance rentals/water/sewer/trash/late fees/other)

- Provide the total amount you currently owe on Base rent.
- Provide how much assistance you are requesting.
- Provide how much of your own money you will contribute towards the total base rent owed? (Please note that Daystar will not cover 100% of the rent owed.)

Please use the link below and fill out the form completely in order to make an application for the current monthly only rental assistance. This program will assume that you have already paid all past months' rents and due to an emergency listed above, you need assistance to pay the January rent. If you don't have access to a cell phone or computer, you can come into our center and use the resource room to apply. You must bring your required documents with you.
