


# What is cross-listing?

Students and teachers are added to Canvas courses. Teachers create learning content in the courses so the students can access it.


## Common Problem:

- You add learning content to Canvas courses
- You have several courses that have the same content
- You have to **create** the content multiple times
- You have to **maintain** the content in multiple places.



## Solution:

- You can move the section of students from several courses into one single course. This means you would use one Canvas course with multiple “sections” within it and can create content and maintain that content within the single live course.



### Vocabulary:

- *Section* - Container of the enrollments of a Canvas course. You can have multiple sections within one course but you must have at least one section.

### What Can Be Assigned to Individual Sections?

- Inbox messages
- Assignments
- Announcements
- Quizzes
- Discussions
- Due Dates
- Accessibility Dates

### Setup & Use Overview:

- Go to the section of the course you wish to move. Select “Cross-List this Section”.
- Find the course you wish to move it to in a search box. Select it. Push the button, “Cross-List this Section”.
- Maintain the content and assignments within the one course with all the sections of students. Gradebook passback will pass grades to the separate Infinite Campus sections as before.

**IMPORTANT:** Grades do not come with the section when cross-listing. Be sure to [backup your gradebook](#), if you've taken grades already, before cross-listing.

### Comparison to Blueprint Courses:

- Blueprint courses need to be setup by your Canvas Controller before you can use them.
- You still have multiple courses to go into for grading and feedback.
- Additional benefit of cross-listing is being able to have discussions between the students of multiple sections (especially useful for small sections from Infinite Campus, special ed, AP, etc.).
