TERM	DEFINITION
SONS OF LIBERTY	A group that started in Boston. Its goal was to PROTEST BRITISH POLICIES. LATER TO WIN INDEPENCE
STAMP ACT	A tax on all PAPER products that made many colonists angry. The purpose for the tax was to PAY OFF BRITISH WAR DEBTS
PROCLAMATION OF 1763	An imaginary line along the Appalachian mountains that BANNED COLONISTS FROM MOVING WEST OF THE MOUNTAINS.
BOSTON TEA PARTY	An act of rebellion where the Sons of Liberty DESTROYED \$1.5 MILLION DOLLARS WORTH OF BRITISH
BOSTON MASSACRE	5 colonists were killed on King Street in a riot where British soldiers shot angry colonists who were threatening them. It was made out to be worse than it was in an engraving by PAUL REVERE
PROPAGANDA	Anything created to PERSUADE AN AUDIENCE TO BELIEVE SOMETHING. It does not have to be true.
SAM ADAMS	Failure at many things in his life before the Sons of Liberty. Charismatic "leader" of the SONS OF LIBERTY.
JOHN HANCOCK	Merchant, wealthiest man in New England. Smuggled goods into Boston Harbor. Cared more for the patriot cause as time passed; signed his name LARGEST on the Declaration of Independence.
GEORGE WASHINGTON	Virginian who was chosen to lead THE CONTINENTAL ARMY
1ST CONT. CONGRESS	The first attempt to unify the colonies against England; it took place in Philadelphia. GEORGIA skipped out. They were being attacked by Creek Indians and needed the British soldiers to help out.
BATTLE OF LEXINGTON AND CONCORD	First official shots fired to start the war. Happened in two locations. LEXINGTON: we Lost. CONCORD: we Crushed
TORIES/LOYALISTS	Loyal to ENGLAND AND THE KING
WHIGS/PATRIOTS	Colonists who wanted to SEPARATE FROM ENGLAND
REDCOATS OR LOBSTERBACKS	Insulting NICKNAMES given to British soldiers by Patriots
PAUL REVERE	Silversmith and strong patriot; Midnight ride to warn Adams/Hancock
boycott	NOT BUYING GOODS IN ORDER TO PROTEST
2nd Cont. Congress	DO NOT NEED TO KNOW THIS FOR UNIT 3
