



GUIDELINES & REQUIREMENTS FOR NOMINATION

1. Age Requirement

- Must be 15–30 years old at the time of nomination.

2. Residency Requirement

- Must be a resident of Victory Norte for at least 1 year.
- Must provide proof of residency

3. Good Standing

- Must have no pending criminal or disciplinary record

4. Demonstrated Achievements or Contribution

Candidates must show notable involvement or accomplishments in any of the following fields:

- Leadership & Governance
- Community Service & Volunteerism
- Academics / Education
- Sports
- Arts & Culture
- Environment & Sustainability
- Entrepreneurship or Innovation
- Youth Empowerment

5. Profile / Resume

- Submit a 1–2 page Profile or Resume

6. Narrative Essay (Minimum 300 Words)

The essay must describe the nominee's:

- Contribution
- Leadership
- Achievements
- Impact on the community

7. Supporting Documents (ANY of the following):

- Certificates of participation or achievement
- Photos of community involvement
- Portfolio, performance records, or project reports
- Testimonials or feedback from beneficiaries



8. Submission Deadline

- All requirements must be submitted on or before December 20, 2025

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

1. Leadership — 10%

Ability to lead, influence, and mobilize others; involvement in youth or community organizations.

2. Community Service & Contribution — 15%

Impact and involvement in volunteer work, public service, and social responsibility.

3. Achievements / Excellence — 25%

Recognitions, awards, skills/talents demonstrated, projects completed, or measurable accomplishments.

4. Character, Integrity & Values — 10%

Good moral standing, honesty, discipline, teamwork, respect, and positive attitude.

5. Impact to the Community — 10%

Sustainability, reach, and long-term effect of their work on the Victory Norte community.

6. Panel Interview — 30%

Assessed based on communication skills, clarity of responses, leadership insight, confidence, and alignment with youth empowerment values.
