New Canon EOS-1D X Mark II Features:

- Dual Pixel CMOS AF & Movie Servo AF for high speed, high frame rate and continuous autofocus during video shooting.
- ISO 409,600 highest expansion
- Dual DIGIC 6+ Processors
- 4k Video (4096 x 2160 DCI format to get UHD you'll have to crop) up to 60p (note NO c-log options) Video options 23.98p, 29.97p, 59.94p in both 1080 and 4k
- 120fps video in HD
- Video Codecs Motion JPEG and .mov in ALL-I and IPB (in mp4, it is IPB Lite)
- up to 14fps full-res RAW or JPEG (with full AF and AE) and up to 16fps (locked AF and AE) in Live View Mode (mirror locked up)
- capture up to 170 RAW images in one burst at up to 16fps with the CFast card slot (71ish with the normal CF slot)
- 20.2mp Full-frame CMOS sensor

- LCD isn't a flippy-dippy screen (articulating) didn't really expect it thow

The Good, Bad, and Ugly of the new Canon EOS-1D X Mark II for Filmmakers!

- 1. HDMI out is only HD not 4k
- 2. Nice updates in Dual-Pixel AF functionality
- 3. 1.3 crop factor for 4k video
- 4. no zebras, etc
- 5. touch screen only for focussing no menus!

-Deejay's gripe, Motion Jpeg?! Really? The 1dc suffered from banding issues and it's a funky format that doesn't work well with all NLE. Also expect very large file sizes, figure ruffly 16 min for a 64Gb card. Also you might be better off transcoding to DNxHD or Prores.

Less expensive than the <u>Nikon D5</u> \$6500 v.s. \$6000 <u>Here's a nice comparison of the current know specs.</u>

Nikon is limited to 30fps and UHD (3840x2160) at a crop of 1.3x, while Canon is offering full DCI 4k (4096x2160) and a 1.4x crop



Sony A6300 4k Video and World's Fastest Autofocus for \$1k! Significant Features:

- 4k Video internal
- 24.2mp APS-C sensor
- 11fps stills!
- 0.05 second autofocus speed
- 425 phase detection AF points (no. 425 is not a typo)
- ISO 100-51,200
- E-mount can use A-mount lenses with adapter
- 4k internal recording in Super35 they're taking 20mp of the sensor, recording 6k video and oversampling it to 4k
- 14 stops of Dynamic Range (DR)
- 4k up to 100Mbps bit rate without pixel binning (50Mbps in HD)

Price on this guy is looking very good. At just shy of \$1000, 4k at a 1.5 ish crop (s35) factor is pretty sexy and of course you can combine this with a <u>Metabones speedbooster</u> to get all of your Canon glass into close to full frame video. (supports S-log2 and S-log3)

Low light performance of the 24mp sensor seems to be about the same as the a6000,



New <u>G-master line of Full frame Sony E-mount lenses</u>. Finally Sony's giving us a 24-70mm f2.8 and 70-200mm f2.8 with built in IS in the latter. G-master sounds a little like a porn title. As will most of sony's offerings, expect to open your wallet for these new lenses. The 24-70 is expected to retail at \$2200 US.
