## Week 8: Open Educational Resources in the Sciences and Health Sciences

## Description

This week, you learned about the Open Access movement and Open Education Resources. In this activity, you'll find additional open education resources in your major that will potentially be added to your library's list of OERs.

## Instructions

- 1. Visit your library's website to find the list of Open Education Resources by subject (or ask your supervisor for a link). If your library doesn't have a curated list, find the research guide on the library website for your major.
- 2. On your own, find three freely available resources for potential inclusion on the OER page and/or the research guide. These resources should be useful for other students in your major. For each resource, include:
  - a. The title of the resource
  - b. A link to the resource
  - c. A short description
  - d. A few sentences evaluating the source (quality, relevancy, author credentials, etc) and why you think it should be included as a resource for other students to use.
