In order for students to be awarded college credit through the AP exam, students must earn a minimum of a "3". Students who earn a "3", "4", or "5" may be eligible for college credit. Students must request the AP transcript be sent to IRSC for evaluation and translation. **IRSC will determine what college credit their institution will award.
