Causing screams from Vexoria, bouts of laughter from chat and generally snickering from our antics. We didn't talk much privately but we always appeared to be on the same wavelength in terms of 'being little shits' for our boss.

It was this time as well, I noticed he would do these antics to other people. Mainly Redclaw and Momo, the first being someone I would later moderate for as well. He dropped these on people seemingly without thought, just wanting to cause funny moments and to give support to friends and content creators he loved.

We would both be known as the chaos gremlins in Vex's community, causing havoc for someone that was my kamioshi and someone he admired as well.

We shared the odd DM to each other but not much.

Moderating (Redclaw) -

I joined Redclaw's team around March 2025, give or take. This was another content creator that Foamy also moderated for. This escalated our chaos antics to another level. It would also get me to know Momo as well but that is for another time.

Red threatening to bury him, Red screaming at me and foamy both created devious memes about him. It was like we were partners in crime. Gremlins on the loose. But it was all in good fun, good jest and good nature. I felt like I was a part of a friend circle, a circle where I could enjoy my time online with others. Foamy helped with that a lot and I could never express what that meant to me.

I adore redclaw and the mod team I work with. The people I have gotten to know. But gaining this friendship with Foamy helped ease a lot of the anxiety of not really knowing anyone in the team.

The start of my own streaming -

I had streamed a few times by this point(around the start of February), with hardly any people swinging by except for the odd bot. But I would suddenly see a familiar face in my chat. It was Foamy. I can't even begin to describe how good it felt to have someone I know, I work with and hardly interacted with privately, to come by MY stream of almost 0 viewers.

It gave me the confidence boost I needed to continue pursuing my dream of streaming full time.

Then around May, after we helped with Vexoria's subathon around May time...I decided to approach him with an idea, inspired by Papamutt's vtuber game show.

I have always been very anxious and scared of approaching people for things, I still am. But with foamy, it didn't feel like that at all. It felt almost natural.

I would discuss with him the idea of a warhammer game show, with the odd silly chaos rounds and we threw ideas back and forth. This would be the start of us talking more regularly and I also felt the start of a friendship.

Yes, it does mean we only have been friends for around 4 months really. It feels like I have known him for much longer. We clicked on many things, shared similar hobbies and of course, shared the same chaos gremlin brain cell.

Soon enough, he would be the first collaboration partner I had. It was me popping on his stream to chat about warhammer preview, sharing our excitement and disdain for the releases.

Following on from this, he would ask me to play in TableTop Sim games with him, usually Oldhammer games. Every game was an absolute blast and both of our chats would have a lot of fun.



Verdict -

I think it is safe to say that Foamy is the most supportive friend I have ever known. I never saw someone who would give so much to the friends they care for and be there for them when needed. It might just be to cause chaos or being an annoying little shit but he is there for them.

He is passionate and driven for his hobbies and his interests. I never knew someone to retain almost the entire Oldhammer knowledge in his head.
