Cold winter weather is approaching soon! Do you need assistance with warm clothing for your kids? Do you have new or gently used items you would like to donate? Read below for more information:

Lexia Core5 Reading

Please have your student start using Lexia. Lexia Core5 Reading is a technology based literacy program that provides differentiated literacy instruction for students of all abilities. It helps students master foundational reading skills and is highly interactive for all types of learners. We will begin having your child login and use Lexia this week. Once you login, the program will have your child take an assessment to place them at their own level. It is important that you do not help your child with Lexia or it may not place them in the correct level. After the assessment, students will be given a weekly goal of how many minutes to complete in a week. Again, it is important that your child works without any help while using Lexia. All of their work is recorded and guides us to see where help is needed for additional instruction. Here is a short [video](#) demonstrating how to log into Lexia Core5.

Audio & Microphone Issues on the Chromebooks

Please make sure to keep your Chromebook operating system up to date by doing the following:

1. Video 1 is the process involved to update the Chromebook operating system. [Here is](#) the 90 second video.
2. Video 2 is how to adjust the microphone volume. [Here is](#) a 47 second video. They have found 50% mic volume is good but this might vary depending on the model of Chromebook. Full mic volume creates a lot of crackly, staticy noise as has been reported.
