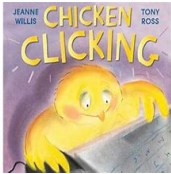


Chicken Clicking

VOCABULARY	Online- When you use a computer, tablet, or phone to connect to the internet Share- To let someone else use or have something that is yours Personal information-Important details about you, like your name, address, or phone number. Private information- Information that is meant to be kept secret and not shared with others. Online friend-A person you talk to and play with on the internet, but you may not have met them in real life. Password: a secret picture, word or set of words that are needed to log into computers and/or websites. Protect: to keep safe
STORY QUESTIONS	How do you think Chicken felt when he realized all his friends were gone? Answer: He probably felt lonely and sad. Where does Chicken go when he sneaks into the farmer's house? Answer: He goes to the computer. What does Chicken start doing on the computer? Answer: He starts buying gifts for everyone. Why does Chicken decide to buy a friend online? Answer: Because all his farm animal friends are gone. What kind of information does Chicken share online? Answer: His name, picture, age, etc. Was the information he shared private or personal information? Answer: Private Information What lesson can we learn from Chicken's actions in the story? Answer: It's important to be careful about what we share online and not to go overboard with buying things. What could Chicken have done differently to avoid the trouble he got into? Answer: He could have asked for help from an adult before using the computer.
ACTIVITY	This is a very introductory activity to teach students about being safe on the Internet. Have a discussion about privacy and how PRIVATE INFORMATION should never be shared with others online. ● Phone number ● Address ● Birth date ● School ● Password Have a discussion about what PERSONAL INFORMATION can be shared with others online. ● Favorite food ● Name of Pet



	● Favorite Sport Read the Story, have conversations about what online friends are versus friends in real life. Optional videos are listed under resources to help with digital citizenship concept.
