EXTENDED ABSTRACT TITLE

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ABSTRACT

This is an extended abstract template for 3rd ICoHoTS2025, which will be held from 10-11 September 2025 by Faculty of Hospitality, Tourism and Wellness, Universiti Malaysia Kelantan, Malaysia. It is anonymous to facilitate the blind-review process (information that can describe the authors' details, including the acknowledgement, shall be removed). The extended abstract contains the following: i) abstract (briefly describe this study by referring to the elements in the title of the study), ii) purpose and background, iii) methodology, iv) findings, v) conclusions, vi) originality, and vii) references. Please use the format below with a maximum number of four-page for the extended abstract. Save your extended abstract as a Microsoft Word PC format. The abstract should be **typed in single-spaced in 10-points Times New Roman and not be more than 200 words**.

Keywords: Keyword 1, Keyword 2, Keyword 3 (Min 3 Keywords & Max 5 Keywords)

PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND

Provide a brief overview of the research topic, define the problem or question, and state its significance. Outline objectives or hypotheses and highlight how the study fills gaps in existing knowledge.

Author should follow the following guidelines. The extended abstract should be written in MS Word format in **single-spaced in 12-point Times New Roman except for abstract. Do not indent the text paragraphs. Each paragraph must be a single-spacing separated (Click icon '¶' at the Home Tools).**

Authors are requested to submit the extended abstracts in electronic form (MS-Word) via our Online Submission. Please ensure the extended abstract has a **minimum of 4 pages** in length excluding the references. The **pages should not be numbered**.

E-proceedings will be published on the conference website. After the conference, selected submissions will be invited to be extended into full papers for publishing in SCOPUS indexed journals.

METHODOLOGY

Summarize the research design, data collection methods, sample selection, analysis techniques, and ethical considerations, ensuring clarity for validity assessment.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

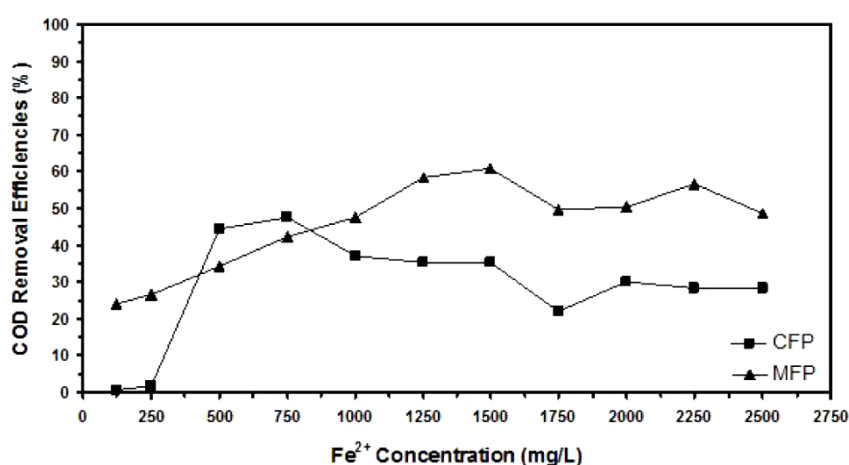


Figure 1. Example of figure for the extended abstract.

Present key findings clearly and logically, interpreting their relevance to the research question. Highlight significant or unexpected results and offer practical recommendations for stakeholders, practitioners, and future research. Please observe Figure 1 and Table 1 to include figure and table in the extended abstract, respectively. A figure should be inserted like the one below and referred to in the text.
