

Hello ASD Families.

Today we're going to talk about transportation this video is to show you how to locate your students bus route. The first thing you're going to need to do is go to the Auburn school district homepage. Once at the home page please look on the right-hand side where it says I'm looking for, select transportation and bus routes. This is the transportation's web page you'll notice you're right where you need to be to locate the bus. The username is guest, and the password is guest. Click on, find your bus stop. Type in guest and password guest and then hit log in.

Step one: select the grade of your student from the drop-down menu. Step two: place your address in, and step three, hit find school transportation info. Now you're at the location map and it shows you that your student is a Mount Baker middle school student. It shows that the bus stop is on Thomas Ave. SE at 66th St. SE. The bus arrives at 6:55 AM and the bus number is 134. The afternoon bus return trip is the same bus number ,134. It arrives at 2:29 PM. The same location on Thomas Ave. SE 66th St. SE. To the right shows you a little map of your house address and location of pick up and drop off. This is very small so you must use the tools in the upper top left corner to zoom in. Click on that and adjust the map so you can see it better. Again, the very top part is your morning route, and the bottom is your afternoon route for return. The map shows your house, and it shows you a location of the pickup and drop off.
