In the next paragraph, the author describes at least five previous studies that are relevant to the research topic. From these previous studies, the authors can explain the gaps and research differences, so that they can formulate a state of the art or research novelty.

In the next paragraph, the author should explain the research method which consists of elements; research design/type/approach, data and data sources, data collection techniques, and data analysis.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION

In the first sub-chapter;

The author explains the theoretical framework of the research that is relevant to the discussion. Theory must be operational. In the sense that the theory used is by the research topic. The theory is quoted from primary references and strengthened by developer theory obtained from secondary references. It is not allowed to review theories at length if they are not related to the discussion.

Second sub-chapter;

The author explains the exposure of the research data. The data is presented in tabular form for the APA 7th Edition model and is accompanied by accurate references. Data presentation must use triangulation techniques (observation, interviews, and documentation) except for literature research.
