## Group Value Sort Instructions and Reflection Questions

- Visit the Value Sort activity tool at <https://value-sort.thegoodproject.org/>
- Create an account by clicking the “Log In” button in the upper right and then using the “Sign up” link.
- When you are logged in, set up an “event code” for your class or group using the “Create Event” button from the homescreen. Name the event. You will then be redirected to a page that displays the event name and a code.
- Provide the code to each of the people taking part in the event. From the value sort homepage, they should use the “Join Event” button and input the code.
- Each individual should then complete their own value sort. The program will automatically compile the group’s responses to show the aggregate rankings of the values to the event creator.
- To view aggregate rankings, ensure you are logged into the account where you created the event. Click the icon in the upper right and click on your profile. Then, click the Events tab and navigate to your results.
- Present the group with the top four values most commonly chosen by the entire group.
- Together, discuss these values, using the following questions to start the conversation:
  - Are you surprised by any of these values?
  - Is there something you expected to be among the top four values that isn’t?
  - Look at your own top values. When you look at the top values of our class, do you see any major differences that surprise you?
  - Are there values that you believe are important to doing good work that are not included in these top four?
