There were many positive comments from parishioners & guests alike regarding the music. Once the Easter season ends, we will switch to Mass of Creation once again.

The 5:00 Ministry organized music for **First Communion** on April 26th during which fourteen young people received their First Communion. Fr. Steven Bell, who was here for our Parish Mission, co-celebrated the liturgy with Fr. Jozef. Guitarist Frank M. accompanied the kids in singing the Gathering song, 'Open My Eyes', while First Communion parents Lisa K. & Monica H. co-cantored the Psalm. Several guest musicians also joined our Saturday regulars, including pianist Victoria K. Huge thanks to Amy T. (Director of Faith Formation) for coordinating this lovely celebration!
