Attendance Expectations

Regular, consistent rehearsal attendance and performance participation is critical for both the singer and the ensemble to be successful. Consistent rehearsal attendance and performance participation will give each singer the opportunity to grow both musically and personally.

Similarly, the ensemble as a whole cannot reach its full potential if every singer is not present and contributing.

To this end, there are attendance requirements for participation in our choral program. Please review the requirements below and sign to indicate your understanding of the attendance policy.

- Singers are allowed up to 3 absences per semester (August-December and January-May). If a singer has more than 3 absences per semester for any reason, concert performance privilege may be revoked.
- Please email (email address here) when you realize that your child must be absent from a rehearsal or event.
- The director should be informed of unavoidable absences as far in advance as possible. Email is best for this purpose, but a written note is also acceptable.
- Final rehearsals preceding concerts are critical for success, and therefore attendance is mandatory. The director has discretion to revoke performance privileges for singers who miss the final rehearsal.
- Attendance is expected for performances in any venue. Conflicts must be discussed with the director in advance.
- Please guard against tardiness by planning to arrive at all rehearsals and performance calls 10 minutes early. Valuable vocal skill-building instruction takes place at the beginning of each rehearsal.
- Attendance and punctuality are factors for ensemble advancement. Excessive absences are grounds for dismissal from the program.

Singer Expectations

Singers will receive music and a music folder. The folder and music are on loan from the choir. Please care for your folder and music and bring them to each rehearsal and performance. Singers should keep a pencil in their music folders.

Uniform Requirements

Visual uniformity is an important aspect of choral performance. For this reason, a t-shirt has been provided to your singer that they should wear, along with jeans (no holes) or khakis, for all performances.
