

PAAS Portfolio Requirements 6th-12th Grade Overview

- ❖ Your portfolio must be turned into your PAAS Art Teacher by **February 9, 2026** in a manilla folder or a legal size, yellow envelope.
- ❖ The portfolio must contain the following 4 total pieces of artwork and be submitted on time, or you will not be able to adjudicate this school year.
- ❖ Each piece of artwork must be individually labeled with your full name, school, and grade.
- ❖ Anime drawings are not allowed in your portfolio submission.
- ❖ Artwork submitted in your portfolio will not be returned and is a permanent part of your PAAS art portfolio.

Your portfolio must contain the following four artworks:

1. Soda Can Graphite pencil drawing on 8.5 x 11 unlined paper

- Place your soda can in front of you under a strong light.
- The drawing should be done in graphite pencil (not colored) and should include value (lights and darks), line variation and detail,
- The drawing should make use of the entire space.

2. Still life on 8.5 X 11 unlined paper

- Draw a still life that incorporates objects that are significant to you.
- Use colored pencils.
- Show use of space, color, and depth as well as creativity.

3. & 4. Student Choice - Photographed Copies of Artwork (must be printed in color)

- *At least one of your student choice pieces must be an assignment that was completed at school.*
- *The selected items should highlight your skill, insight, and creativity. Variety is important.*
- *Your artwork must be recent- it must be from the past two years.*
- *While part of the process is selecting your best pieces, you may seek the advice of your PAAS Art teacher when selecting work.*
- *Copies of your artworks must be photographed and printed in color. If you need assistance photographing your artwork, please seek your PAAS Art teacher for assistance.*

****You must submit all four artworks to have a complete portfolio.***
