5. New Business:

a. Meet & Confer updates

Meet and Confer is a committee of students chaired by the GSA President that meets monthly with Dr. Bruce Jarrell (UMB President), Dr. Roger Ward (Interim Provost, Executive Vice President & Dean of the Graduate School), Dr. Erin Golembewski (Senior Associate Dean of the Graduate School) and other campus leadership

- ii. Next meeting scheduled for June 16th at 8am
- b. USMSC Updates

The University System of Maryland Student Council meets monthly and includes two representatives from each USM Institution (UMB's are the GSA and USGA Presidents)

- Last meeting occurred May 22nd and was just elections
- ii. Next meeting in the Fall semester
- c. Campus Safety
 - Last Citizens Advisory Board meeting occurred May 16
 - Finally got the first draft of the student address data! Next meeting going to compare student clusters that are not covered by the shuttle or safe ride/walk

- ii. Next meeting sometime in June
- d. UMB Shuttle
 - Last meeting May 11
 - Brought up concern that drivers are driving by students waiting for the shuttle
 - Tony emphasized that students should be "waving their arms" to be seen & requested specific stop/route info for where this has occurred
 - b. Reston asserted that drivers *always* slow down or stop at all stops regardless whether they see anyone
 - 2. Still waiting for ridership data and information about the impending rate increase, rumors about route changes
 - a. Asked why drivers are seemingly recording numbers of people getting on at each stop—apparently the new fancy ridership system can only count the total number of people that ride the shuttle, NOT when/which stop they get on. So drivers will always have to record this info manually
 - Brought up concerns about the pull cords (sound staying on; volume too quiet so drivers not hearing it/missing stopes) & Reston going to check all busses
 - a. Requested that Reston also communicate with their drivers to *ask* if the volume is an issue to them, because Robert Milner asserted that he/his office rides the shuttles regularly to make sure everything is fine and they hadn't noticed an issue here
 - 4. Shuttle Committee doesn't meet in the summer because "students are off"--requested that they check in with the GSA in lieu of a meeting since many research students work year-round; still send us any concerns you have over the summer!
