This is $\ensuremath{\mathbf{NOT}}$ your login for your school computer / compass etc.

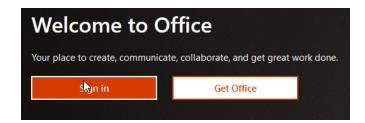

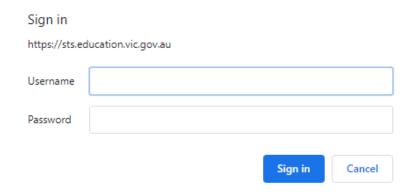


Step 2. Enter your school email address

Installing Office

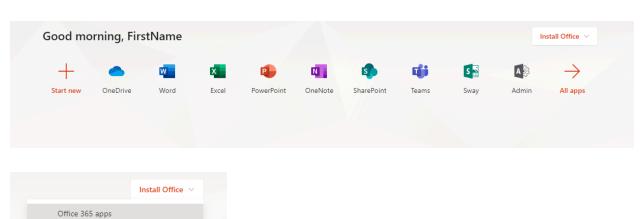
Some devices come with Office 365 pre-installed - If you already have Office, you can skip this step and move onto activation.

Step 1. Click Install Office

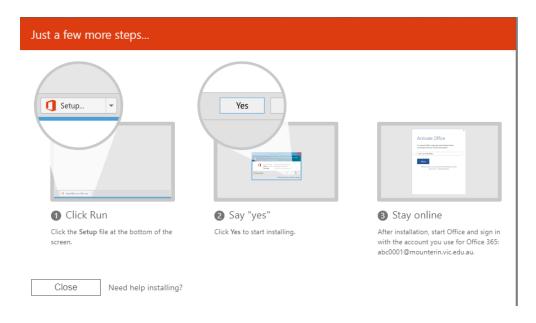
Includes Outlook, OneDrive for Business, Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and ore.
