

BLOOMINGTON CAREER ACADEMY (BCA)

Bloomington Career Academy is an option for our junior and senior students. Students must be on-track to graduate and maintain a 1.5 GPA in order to attend BCA. Attendance and disciplinary issues are also considered prior to being approved for admittance into a student's desired program. If questions arise, the final decision rests with the principal.

Students attending BCA programs are required to ride the transportation provided by the LeRoy School District. Students need to select from 1st or 3rd section courses.

To apply, students fill out a digital application which opens early November for acceptance into programs for the following school year. See Mrs. Levingston or the BCA website for a link to the application.

Programs fill up quickly! Apply early - if interested. But, don't hesitate to apply late. Students find out in the Spring if they have been placed into their requested course. Those placed on a Wait List can be added into a class up to the start of school.
