(1	Before continuing with the application, we want you to know that in this research we discuss many sensitive and challenging topics, including racism, anti-racism, discrimination, and mental health. Only individuals who can be respectful of the experiences of others (e.g., including sexual and gender identity) are allowed to interact with participants. Do you wish to be considered for potential in-person contact with participants?
