A young lady with a special needs child answers the door. Her son of 4 has autism and he smiles when he sees Chris at the door.

"Hello, sorry about my son, he's a little rambunctious around new people. How can I help you?" The young mother tries to hold her son who's trying to play with Chris.

"It's quite alright miss, I have two daughters of my own, both full of life and energy just like this future bundle of greatness." Chris gives her son a high five.

"My name is Chris Frost ma'am, I hope that I do not come as a nuisance but I wish to speak to you about the upcoming Senate election this week. Would you mind if we could talk about it?" Chris politely asks understanding her current situation the young lady is dealing with.

"No, not at all. Would you just give me a second to get my son under control? I am going to put him in the back yard and let his father watch over him for a few minutes. We're grilling for a barbeque soon."

"Please take your time. I just hope my stomach can handle the amazing smell." Chris allows the mother to bring her son to his father.

After a few minutes, the lady returns to Chris. "So, what exactly do you wish to talk to me about in relation to the election?" The lady asks with a somewhat concerned tone.

"What's your name ma'am?" Chris asks politely.

"Elizabeth, that was my son Trent and my husband Allen is in the back" she answers.

"Very nice to meet you Elizabeth. I wish to address some things with you. Firstly this state has faced its share of hardships, just recently in March when Governor OKBlackBelt went head-on with Second Amendment Sanctuary Counties and Pro-Second Amendment Militias. The actions he took were not only overzealous but also overexaggerated. No crime was ever committed by these militias nor did any of the counties act in a way that could be seen as rebellious.
