General Staff Policies

Disrespecting other staff or members of the community will result in disciplinary actions and repeat offenders may face a permanent ban.

Staff are to follow guidelines and rules that are given to them by either their mentor, or an Administrative Lead (A.L).

Staff are to follow COC (Chain of Command), which means reporting directly to their Mentor, or one rank higher from them.

Staff are to be professional, as well as use the necessary channels for their input.

Staff are to actively pass on any suspicious information that may happen in game, Discord, TeamSpeak, or the Website.

Staff are representing the Chronic Networks Community, which means they must act civil, and follow the rules, and guidelines.

Staff are not to give out any personal information about a players steam ID, real name, etc that they may receive.

Staff are to not give out any information about other staff members, or anything related to the staff team.

Staff are to be civil, and follow their rules and guidelines, on any other discord or Rust server in which one may be in. Failure to do so may result in a possible demotion, removal, and or suspension.

Staff are not to act biased against any players in handling any type of situation. You are to act mature, calm, and patient.

Staff are not allowed to start any type or argument, rebellion, or anything that will start a commotion.

Never enforce rules that are not listed in the following places: website, Discord, TeamSpeak, and In game.

Higher ranking staff always have the final say, never argue with a higher ups decision unless they themselves are breaking a rule. If that is the case, contact their superior immediately.

Always follow the chain of command, unless it's of worthy importance that you go to a ranking that has the power and authority to do so.

Always have evidence before making a calm, and or punishing that player, seek punishment guidelines to assist you.

The punishment for not following these offenders can and will result in a demotion, suspension, or even a removal from the team.
