



Mission Opportunities at Frisco Bible Church

The Primary Role of the Mission Ministry at Frisco Bible Church is to encourage, equip, support, and facilitate missionally living- “doing the great commission by the power of the Holy Spirit for the Glory of God” in every FBC congregant.

Here are the missional living opportunities to *serve and share your faith* with Frisco Bible Church. We have monthly, quarterly, and yearly opportunities. All of these ministries are wonderful ways to serve individually or together as a family.

Here’s a brief highlight of all of our ministries:

Monthly Opportunities:



Showers of Blessings - We host baby showers at our church and minister to moms-to-be who have chosen to give life to their unborn babies. The moms-to-be are clients at the Life Talk Resource Center. One of the favorite highlights of the Shower of Blessings is the prayers spoken over the mom, baby, and father with Scripture. Our team reads the Scripture cards as we pray over the family. The family takes those Scripture cards home. We also need men! Many of the dads-to-be attend the shower, and we need fathers who can talk, encourage, and share.



Laundry Love- We partner with our local laundromat for a monthly event where we help cover the cost of laundry. Anyone who visits the laundromat on the second Saturday of each month can receive two free wash-and-dry loads. Our team creates an atmosphere of worship at the laundromat, and we engage with our guests as they wash their laundry. This is a regular opportunity to serve—by contributing money to the laundry machines and conversing with our guests, seeking gospel opportunities.



Food Pacs-We partner with Children's Hunger Fund to assist families experiencing food insecurity in Collin and Denton counties. These families receive food pacs each month. We connect you with a family, and you deliver the food pacs to their home. This is a monthly chance to serve and is ideal for families to serve together while building relationships through Food Pac deliveries, always seeking gospel opportunities. Food Pac deliveries are scheduled for the first Saturday of each month between 10 AM and 4 PM. Our Food Pac Coordinator will coordinate with your schedule each month. You will need just a two-hour window in your day for this ministry.



Nursing Home- We go to Beehive Home for Seniors in Frisco once a month to hold a worship service for residents who can't attend church. Our team creates a service with music, Scripture reading, a devotional, communion, and prayer opportunities. This monthly event is a chance to serve. We serve on the last Saturday of each month from 3-5 PM. This is another great chance to serve together as a family.



ESL Conversations - A weekly Online English as a Second Language Conversation Class with a host teacher from Frisco Bible Church held on Monday evenings from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM via Zoom. Mission Executive Board- We have an Executive Mission Board that assists the Frisco Bible Director in overseeing the mission ministry, both globally and locally, including strategic planning, mission trips, and sponsorship opportunities. Our Executive Board meets six times a year. If you have a passion for missions and enjoy nonprofit board work, this could be an excellent opportunity to serve. There is an application process and an interview with the mission's director before serving. This process helps ensure unity and fit within the board as we seek to glorify God through The Great Commission.



Life Talk Resource Center- Our crisis pregnancy center in Frisco, which we partner with to host the Showers of Blessings, is always looking for Client Advocates, especially men. They provide training and will work with your schedule.



Mission Trips-Global mission trip opportunities include serving, teaching, evangelism, discipleship, or a combination of these activities. Participants in an international mission trip with Frisco Bible Church must be at least 18 years old. Children aged 12-17 can participate if they are accompanied by a parent over 21. A Mission Trip Application and a security deposit set by the mission's director must be completed and paid to reserve your spot for each trip. Team meetings and training are required for each participant. You must have a valid passport and all necessary vaccinations for the country you're traveling to. Special Events- Once a Year Opportunities to Serve:



Operation Christmas Child, run through Samaritan's Purse, aims to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way to children worldwide by packing shoeboxes. Churches across our nation distribute empty shoeboxes to their congregants, who fill them for boys and girls around the world. Each box offers an opportunity to share the gospel of Christ with a child. We are always seeking volunteers to help distribute and collect boxes and bring them to the distribution center.

Drop off Location (DOL) Leader. This opportunity is available for one week each year, with two hours of collection at the church daily during OCC National Collection Week (the second week of November). During this time, we gather OCC boxes from other churches in the Collin/Denton County area. Check back with us in September or October for the OCC DOL dates in 2026.



Summer Lunch Program through Frisco Family Services. The Summer Lunch Program is a nine-week feeding initiative that supports kids in Frisco ISD who qualify for free and reduced lunch. This is a once-a-year ministry opportunity that takes place during the summer. Frisco Bible Church participates by serving one week (Monday through Friday) of the nine-week program. It is a wonderful family service opportunity, especially if you have elementary-aged children. **Our 2026 Serving Week will be from Monday through Friday in June 15-19 from 10:30 AM to 12:30 PM at various locations.** Please check our mission website for sign-ups to serve and to donate non-perishable food items as the dates approach.



We partner with a local store in Frisco for one Saturday morning each year during our off-campus event.
