



Local Mission Opportunities at Frisco Bible Church

The Primary Role of the Mission Ministry at Frisco Bible Church is to encourage, equip, support, and facilitate missionally living- “doing the great commission by the power of the Holy Spirit for the Glory of God” in every FBC congregant.

Here are the missional living opportunities to Serve & Share Your Faith with Frisco Bible Church. We have monthly, quarterly, and yearly opportunities. Monthly Opportunities:



Showers of Blessings- We host baby showers at our church and minister to moms-to-be who have chosen to give life to their unborn baby. The moms-to-be are clients at Life Talk Resource Center. One of the favorite highlights of the Shower of blessing is the prayers prayed over mom, baby & the father with Scripture. Our team reads the Scripture cards as we pray over the family. The family takes those Scripture cards home. We need men too! Many of the dads-to-be attend the shower and we need fathers who can talk, encourage, and share.



Laundry Love- We partner with our local laundromat for a once-a-month event where we help pay for the cost of laundry. Anyone who comes into the laundromat on the second Saturday of each month can receive two free wash & dry loads. Our team creates an atmosphere of worship at the laundromat, and we talk with our guests as our guests wash their laundry. This is a monthly opportunity to serve. You are putting money into the laundry machines and talking with our guests looking for gospel opportunities.



Food Pacs- We partner with Children's Hunger Fund and minister to families with food insecurities within Collin & Denton County. The families receive these food pacs monthly. We partner you with a family and you deliver the food pacs to their place of residence. This is a monthly opportunity to serve and is great for families to serve together and build a relationship with our families through Food Pac deliveries always looking for gospel opportunities. Food Pac Deliveries are done on the first Saturday of each month between 10AM and 4PM. Our Food Pac Coordinator will work with your schedule each month.



Nursing Home- We head over to Beehive Home for Seniors in Frisco for a once-a month event where we conduct a worship service for the residents who are unable to attend church services. Our team puts together a worship service with music, Scripture reading, devotional, communion, and opportunities to pray. This is a monthly opportunity to serve. We serve on the last Saturday of every month from 3-5 PM. This is another wonderful opportunity to serve together as a family.



Cornerstone Baptist Church- A monthly serving opportunity in South Dallas. We have an opportunity to serve on the second of Thursday of each month at Cornerstone Baptist Kitchen. We will meet at FBC first at 9:00 AM and return at 2:00 PM.



ESL Conversations - A weekly Online English as a Second Language Conversation Class with a host teacher from Frisco Bible Church held on Monday evenings from 7:00PM to 8:30 PM via Zoom. Mission Executive Board- We have an Executive Mission Board that helps the FBC Director oversee the mission ministry both globally and locally from strategic planning, mission trips to Sponsorship opportunities. Our Executive Board meets six times per year. If you have a heart for missions and enjoy non-profit board work, then this would be a wonderful opportunity for you to serve. There is an application process & interview with the mission's director prior to serving. This process is for bringing unity & fit within the board as we seek to glorify God with The Great Commission.



Life Talk Resource Center- This is a crisis pregnancy center that we partner with to do the Showers of Blessings. Life Talk is always looking for Client Advocates, especially men. They will do the training and work with your schedule.

Mission Trips- Global mission trips will include serving, teaching, evangelism, discipleship &/or a combination within. Those who participate in a global mission trip with Frisco Bible Church need to be at least 18 years of age. Children who are ages 12-17 may participate in a global mission trip with an accompanied parent who is over 21 years of age. A Mission Trip Application along with a security deposit, set by the mission's director, must be filled out & paid to hold your reservation for each trip. Team meetings & training are required by each participant. You must have a valid passport & all the required vaccinations of the country you are traveling to.

Special Events- Once a Year Opportunities to Serve:



Operation Christmas Child through Samaritan's Purse. The mission of OCC is to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way to children around the world through the packing of a shoebox. Churches around our nation distribute empty shoe boxes to their congregants that are filled for boys and girls to receive around the world. Every box is an opportunity to reach a child with the gospel of Christ. We are always looking for people on our team to help distribute & collect boxes and bring them to the distribution center.

Operation Christmas Child Drop off Location (DOL) Leader. This opportunity is served for one week per year for two hours each day at the church during OCC National Collection Week (2nd week in November) collecting OCC boxes from other churches in the Collin/Denton County area. Check back with us in September/October for the OCC DOL dates in 2025



Summer Lunch Program through Frisco Family Services. The Summer lunch Program is a nine-week feeding program that helps kids who live in Frisco ISD who are on the free and reduced lunch program. This is a once-a-year ministry opportunity that happens in the summer. Frisco Bible Church takes one week (Monday through Friday) of the nine-week serving program. This is a great family service opportunity especially if you have elementary kids. Our 2026 Serving Week will be Monday through Friday in June TBA 10:30 AM to 12:30 PM at various locations. Check our mission website for signups to serve and to donate non-perishable food for this event as we get closer to the dates.



Garments of Love. Garments of Love is a ministry of Frisco Bible Church which helps families with clothing insecurities purchase new clothes. We partner with one of our local stores in Frisco for one Saturday morning each year with our off campus event. We use this ministry event as an evangelistic opportunity to share the gospel and to pray with the families we serve looking for ways to connect them to Christ and Frisco Bible Church. We are excited to bring this event back annually beginning September 19, 2025. Announcements for this event opportunity both to serve and to give will be presented. We are currently looking for people who want to serve on our **Garments of Love Committee.**
