

Post-Secondary Mathematics Award



The OAME/AOEM Award for Exceptional and Creative Teaching in Post-Secondary Mathematics recognizes an exceptional and creative post-secondary educator or team of educators who demonstrates excellence in mathematics education, contributes to the overall development of students, and demonstrates leadership in the mathematics education community.

Award Nomination Process

- 1. As the nominator, provide a one page letter of recommendation explaining why you are nominating this educator/team. Note: the nominator must be an OAME/AOEM member to be able to make a nomination.
- 2. Provide up to three additional letters of support, of no more than two pages each. These supporting documents may be gathered from a variety of sources to reveal a full picture of the nominee. The support documents will provide precise information about the nominee's contributions as they relate primarily to this award. All documentation supporting a nomination should align to the OAME/AOEM Vision for mathematics teaching and learning. Support may come from a supervisor or administrator, parents of students, colleagues, former/current students, or other appropriate sources. The nominations will be assessed according to the criteria outlined below.
- 3. Include the nominee's Curriculum Vitae of up to five pages.
- 4. Complete Google Form and submit all required documentation to OAME Executive Directors at <u>EDs@oame.on.ca</u> by **January 31**.
