1. Contact the CTE Center if you are interested in completing the Master's Degree (cteadvising@temple.edu)
2. The Intern certification should be acquired before you apply to the Graduate School for the M.Ed. program.
3. Apply by completion of 15 credit hours. The Graduate School may not accept hours over the 15 credits towards the degree.
4. You need to matriculate (be accepted as a degree-seeking student) before you register for classes for that semester.
5. Once you are accepted you need to pay the deposit, or have it waived before registering for classes.
6. Must be a continuous student (at least 1 class/semester) or fill out a Leave of Absence request:
 - a. To access the Leave of Absence application, students can sign in to the TUportal and under TUapplications, select Enrollment Services, and then select Services. Select Leave of Absence from the Services menu and complete the necessary information (Temple Bulletin – Graduate)
7. Courses taken at other colleges/universities may not meet the requirements of the degree (even if they meet the requirements of the certification).
8. You are required to follow the Temple University Graduate School policies:

10. The time limit for degree completion is 4 years – this is different than the certification time frames.
